Creating a Picture Book with Al

I used OpenAl technology to write a picture book. The technology assist is very cool.

A prompt is the text we type to an artificial intelligence (AI) to evoke a response:

Human: Who are you?

Al: I am a chatbot who can talk on any subject. What would you like to talk about?

In the dialog above, the prompt is what the Human types: "Who are you?".

We have a dog Margie and I was curious what the OpenAl ChatGPT Al might come up with in a story about one of her favorite stuffed animals. This is the prompt I used for ChatGPT at https://chat.openai.com/chat:

In 500 words or less, write a story about my Labrador Retriever dog Margie's best stuffed animal friend called Bunny. Bunny is a bunny rabbit stuffed animal with big floppy ears. Margie has a whole collection of stuffed animals but she likes Bunny the best and carries Bunny to greet people.

The response that ChatGPT came up with is in the rest of the book. The prompt for the cover image using OpenAI DALL•E 2 at https://openai.com/dall-e-2 is:

A yellow Labrador Retriever dog hugging a plush stuffed gray bunny, digital art


ChatGPT wrote the starting text, and then I added my edits. I broke the text into pages and added the illustrations which were created by OpenAI DALL•E 2, with some graphic editing. I used these DALL•E 2 prompts:

- A yellow Labrador Retriever dog carrying a stuffed gray bunny rabbit in her mouth, digital art
- A yellow Labrador Retriever dog and a stuffed gray bunny walking in the park, digital art. I replaced the bunny with: "A cute plush gray bunny with floppy ears walking, right side, light background, digital art"
- Two labrador retrievers playing with a stuffed bunny animal, digital art
- 3D rendering of children playing with labrador retrievers and a stuffed bunny in a park
- little girl with stuffed bunny and lab retriever, digital art
- little girl crying with labrador retriever and stuffed bunny, digital art
- Happy Labrador Retriever with little girl and stuffed bunny, digital art
- A yellow Labrador Retriever dog is happy with a stuffed bunny, cartoon style



Margie and Bunny


